We could not have done it without your enthusiasm and commitment!


HOUSEKEEPING

Once all the data from the CAPEs you've helped to collect has been received, our statisticians will analyse whether CBT-ts helps to improve recovery outcomes.



After we've received the study results, the team will write up the final report and consider any papers that can be published about the study.
