Thank you all so much for your hard work, we couldn't do it without you! Your enthusiasm has been fantastic!


We have just trained our final cohort in CBT-ts. Your input is essential to the outcome of the trial which ends at the **end of April 2024**.

## HOUSEKEEPING + FAQs

- Remember, the threshold for CAPE+ is >1.30 for both frequency and distress scores.
- Our initial information leaflet for patients describes the research that is happening in the service and what will happen if they are invited and agree to participate.



It is very important that you give this leaflet out with the CAPE questionnaire.

- > You do not need to add any CAPE scores to REDCap.
- > The CAPE is for use with your CBT patients only.
- If you haven't used REDCap for a while, you may find your account has been locked. If this is the case, please let us know and we can quickly get it reactivated.
